
System for borrowing card


Bylaws Revision Request:

ARTICLE III - NEIGHBORHOOD BOUNDARIES

SECTION 3.01: The geographical area which is the focus of the PHCA and which is the geographical boundary by which voting membership will be determined in accordance with Article IV hereof shall be that area known as "Polish Hill" according to the City of Pittsburgh. In addition, the organization recognizes residents of the following areas to be eligible for voting membership:

- Lower Brereton Street, Kenney Way and Stockholm Street
- Lower Melwood Ave to Denver Street
- Monroe Street, Hancock Street, Ridgway Street, Ajax Street and Leander Street





Having trouble paying your heating bill?



The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps families living on low incomes pay their heating bills in the form of a cash grant. Households in immediate danger of being without heat can also qualify for crisis grants. The cash grant is a one-time payment sent directly to the utility company/fuel provider to be credited on your bill. These grants range from \$300 to \$1,000 based on household size, income, and fuel type. Remember: This is a grant and does not have to be repaid.
